The Great Aussie Bush Camp for students in years 3-10 is being held on August 31-Sep 2. The cost will be \$150.

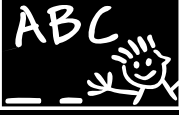
The HSC practical music exams are on Sep 16 from 2:00pm until 5:15pm.
